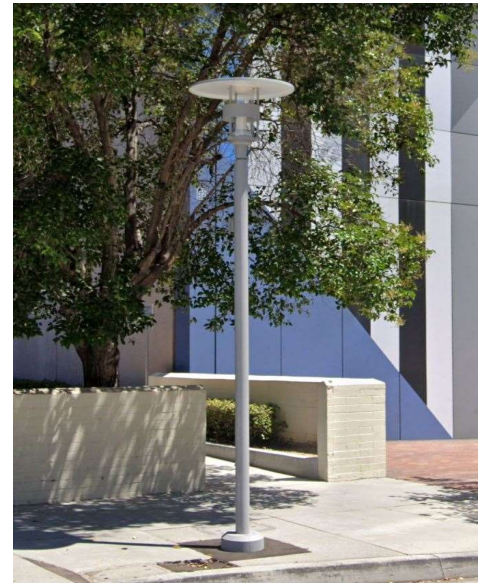


### Project Description

- This project provides streetscape improvements to enhance pedestrian access and circulation along a 1.06-mile segment of Lake Avenue, from the Gold Line Station at Corson Street south to California Boulevard. The addition of pedestrian lighting, controlled mid-block street crossing and accessibility improvements at new and existing signalized intersections will enhance the overall pedestrian experience through this busy commercial corridor.

### Project Improvements

- New traffic signal at Granite Drive
- Signalized mid-block crossing south of Cordova
- In-fill pedestrian scale lighting
- Curb extensions and ADA compliant curb ramps
- Sidewalk widening on Lake north of Colorado
